Office letter dated Jan 20-1881. D. 320-81.
I undertook to make up a company
of Assay youths to be educated at
Carlisle Pa. and found that I could
get three from one band, but the
Indians did not want to let any
go unless I would take the three and
as I had promise other bands the
balance of the company. I consented
to take this one extra. Making sixteen
instead of fifteen
As transportation was furnished for

but please I prefer the transportation
of the one extra with my own. And now
ask that Authority be granted for this
extra one that the expense will
be allowed in my acct.

I have receipt from Lieu Priett for
the sixteen and presume he has
so reported to the office.
