The body of Lawrence I brought with me and shall bury tomorrow at this place, I could not get him home owing to the condition of the Missouri River.

As soon as possible I shall leave for Rosebud Landing and with reasonable success hope soon to be there, Philip the fourth boy is in good health and will go through to Rosebud Agency all right.
