To the Honorable

The Commissioner of Indian Affairs,
Washington, D. C.

Sir:

I have been at some trouble to work up an interest in Philadelphia in behalf of this school and I find there is a spirit of liberality that justifies me in hoping that by a little effort I can raise \$2500. to put a much needed addition to the girls quarters which will give them a room large enough for a sitting room, for instruction, and entertainment, and also put additional dormitories overhead, so that we may give them more sleeping place and be better prepared for any

additional girls, I go to Philadelphia for
a few days in this interest, during my ab-
sence Mr. A. J. Standing will have imme-
diate charge of the school but will refer to
me.
