TRAINING SCHOOL FOR INDIAN YOUTH,

CARLISLE BARRACKS,

Carlisle, Pa., May 30 1881

To the Honorable

The Commissioner of Indian Affairs,

Washington, D.C.

Sir:

The former Florida prisoner Teait-kopeta, a Kiowa who has been for the past three years in the care of Dr. Barthers of Tarrytown, New York, desires to return to his home. He is entitled to be returned at Government expense as were the others, and I request your authority to incur the necessary traveling expense for him from Tarrytown, New York to the Kiowa & Comanche Agency, Ind. Ter.

I ought to say that his health is not good. He speaks better English and in some respects is more advanced than any of the other Florida prisoners.

This will leave but one of these former prisoners remaining east, that is the Kiowa young man Stah-leuk who is helping me in this school.
