Sir,

Horace the son of Coarse Toice, Rufus the son of Black Crow, Morgan the son of Big Star, and Austin the son of Holy Bear from Pine Ridge Agency Dakota, are reported by my Physician to be in such a state of health as to render it necessary they should return to their agency. The first three have consumption, and the last is so filled with berofula as to preclude all reasonable hope of recovery.

I would request your authority to send them to their Agency under the care of one of my employes and incur the necessary expense of transportation. It is desirable that we send them at once.
