I wish to tell you that we are all very happy & doing a very good work here. I am an old man now & I would like to have a one horse buggy given to me.

I have not called my boy, 'Takes his own', home but I leave that to

you and himself
to determine when
he will be skillful
enough to come home
& carry on the work
he is learning now.

I am a friend to all
Chief white men, and
teachers. I wish you
would help me in this
that I ask for.

This is all I can say
this time. I shake hands
with you.
