TRAINING SCHOOL FOR INDIAN YOUTH,

CARLISLE BARRACKS,

Carlisle, Pa., April 17 1882.

To the Honorable

The Commissioner of Indian Affairs,

Washington, D.C.

Sir:

The two Indians Naastoe ^{and} Bigulbau, now here, expect to go to their agency sometime this week. My physician reports that Irvine, a Comanche boy has lung trouble which he feels sure will continue ^{and} disable him. ^{and} thinks it would be better to send him home by this opportunity than to delay until the party goes to that agency sometime this summer or fall.

As these two men have a conveyance waiting for them at Caldwell the expense of sending the boy home will not be material, - only his fare from here to Caldwell. I would therefore request your authority to send the boy home ^{and} to meet the necessary expense. As these men may go very soon I would request the authority by telegram.
