Sir:

I have the honor to acknowledge receipt of Department letter No. 6727. - 3988 April 18th having reference to a company of Osage and Kaw children for Carlisle, and in reply to state, that on the occasion of my recent trip to Muskogee I met Inspector Haworth, who told me the cost of transportation was much less from that point (Muskogee) than from Arkansas City. In view of this information I would suggest that Agent Miles be instructed to deliver the children from his agency (together with the boy from Pawnee referred to in former letter) to me at the nearest station on the Missouri Pacific R.R. east of him; say Carter Springs or Vinita or whatever station may be the most convenient for him. I have not received any
