To the Honorable

The Commissioner of Indian Affairs,
Washington, D.C.

Sir:

Yesterday I received a telegram of which the enclosed is a copy. In compliance with this telegram I met the Geage children in Martinsburg last night at seven o'clock. As there was no train on the Cumberland Valley Railroad until this morning they were necessarily detained over night. The expense of this amounts to \$20.00.

It seems the shortest & best way to cover it into my accounts & I would ask your authority confirming this.
