Sir:

I have the honor to report that there are five (5) scholars, who wish to leave this Agency for Carlisle Barracks Pa. It has been very difficult heretofore to accomplish anything in this direction with this people, but a pupil from that school (half breed Navajo) sent out by Capt. Pratt has helped a good deal to open the lead,

I respectfully ask for authority for the issue of shoes or such other articles of necessary clothing as available to be given them to make the journey, as well as for transportation and expense connected therewith to Railroad Station, and if medical examination necessary, for pay of Physician to perform the same.

Hon. Commissioner 2:

As the school opens early in September
as I am informed, a prompt reply
is very necessary, in order to be in time,
I think they will (the scholars) be expected
to leave by the 21st instant.
