TRAINING SCHOOL FOR INDIAN YOUTH,

CARLISLE BARRACKS,

Carlisle, Pa., Dec. 1st 1882

To the Honorable

The Commissioner of Indⁿ Affs.
Washington, D. C.

Sir,

I have to report the arrival, at this school on the 8:30 A.M. train yesterday, of Rev. Jno. Robinson and Miss Burgess in charge of sixty eight pupils from the Rosebud and Pine Ridge Sioux Agencies, Dakota. Luther S. Bear, Robt. A. Horse and Maggie S. Looking who went with Miss Burgess are much commended by her for their help at the Agencies and en-route.

The transportation I asked you should be at Fort Niobrara, for this party was not there, and the party came east direct over the D. C. & P. & C. M. & St. P. and Penna. Lines.
