TRAINING SCHOOL FOR INDIAN YOUTH,

CARLISLE BARRACKS,

Carlisle, Pa., Dec. 28th 1882

To the Honorable

The Commissioner of Indian Affairs
Washington D. C.

Sir

I have the honor to inform you that I have this day notified Richard M. Parker for himself and as Attorney in fact for the other heirs of Richard Parker dec^d; that I desire to terminate the lease for the farm, as present in the occupancy of the U. S. by this School, containing 109 acres more or less. Said lease being dated March 10th 1881, and approved by your office March 12. 1881, I do this, because of the excessive rent of the land, and in the expectation, of getting this or other land, on more favorable terms.

I will inform you soon, of such arrangement, as I think best to make, in regard to land for use of this School.
