The Commissioner of Indian Affairs
Washington D. C.

Sir,

My Physician reports that Katie La Croix, a pupil from Sisseton Agency, and who has been under treatment for some time, but is still able to be about, and attend School, will undoubtedly go down by Pulmonary disease. From Agent Orissey, who recently visited us, we learn, her mother and a number of her family had died with the same disease. It would seem better that she be returned to her Agency, that we spend no more time or money, where it is so likely to be entirely lost in a short time. I would request your authority, to send her to her home, and make the necessary expenditures for her transportation, and that Agent Orissey, who is now in Washington, be instructed to take her back with him, which I have no doubt he will cheerfully do.
