**TRAINING SCHOOL FOR INDIAN YOUTH,**

**CARLISLE BARRACKS,**

Carlisle, Pa., March 26 1883

To the Honorable

The Commissioner of Indian Affairs  
Washington, D. C.

Sir:

When we returned the Cheyenne pupils last year, one of the boys, named Alfred Brown, who should have gone home at that time, was permitted to remain, having his fathers consent and desiring himself to do so. His father now writes he is getting old, is sick, and thinks he is going to die, and wants his boy to come home, and has sent him money. I would request your permission to send him.

Clement Black Deer, a Cheyenne boy whose three years expire in September has been in Hospital since December with some nervous trouble from which

the Doctor thinks he will be a long time in recovering and that a change will be beneficial to him. I think he had better return to his home now and would request your permission to send him and incur the necessary expense.
