To the Honorable

The Commissioner of Indian Affairs

Washington D.C

Sir.

Jane Freeman, one of our Creek girls, during the whole period of her school life here, now more than two years, has been something of a care on account of her delicate health. Mr. Moore one of the representative men of the nation is here at our Examination and would take charge of her to her home. My Doctor reports that he cannot detect any lung complication but that her general health and appearance indicate a predisposition to pulmonary trouble and as she has always been unable to keep up with the requirements of her school life it would seem

better that she be returned to her people.

I would ask your authority and the necessary allowance for transportation to her home under the care of Mr Moore.
