To the Honorable

The Commissioner of Indian Affairs
Washington D. C.

Sir.

I am in receipt of letter from Agent Miles in regard to Wagon you authorized us to sell to Big Horse. Big Horse asks if the Government will pay the transportation on the Wagon. As it is a long step for him to pay at all I would recommend that the transportation be paid. It will encourage in the right direction. In this connection, I am also in receipt of a letter from Wolf Face Cheyenne who has a boy and girl at Carlisle, asking that I send him a Wagon. I have written him of Big Horse's desire to pay for his, and it would seem as though these leading men who desire Wagons might in this way be led on to buy for themselves,
