To the Honorable

The Commissioner of Indian Affairs.
Washington. D. C.

Sir:

When Agent Riordan was here we canvassed a scheme he had of employing two of our pupils for service in his school -

Robert Stewart a Creek and Antoinette Williams a half blood Navajo.

Agent Riordan informed me he had talked the matter over with you and it met with your approval. They are engaged and wish to get married and go at once to the Agency, and take hold of the work there.

I think it a good plan.

I respectfully request your authority covering me in the expense

of their transportation from Carlisle to
the Navajo Agency Arizona.
