Carlisle, Pa., August 25, 1883.

To the Honorable
The Commissioner of Indian Affairs,
Sir:

Referring to my letter in regard to new pupils, dated the 18th instant, I have to inform you that a private message from Mr. Bryan, Supt. of the Albuquerque school, says that Carlisle could easily get 50 pupils from the Pueblo, if wanted.

We have had great satisfaction in all the pupils from the Pueblos, except those from Juni.

Should it be your desire to take any part of the new pupils from that Agency, I would favor it.
