CARLISLE BARRACKS,

Carlisle, Pa., Sept 10th 1883

To the Honorable

The Commissioner of Indian Affairs.

Washington D. C.

Sir:

It seems best, while we are sending home detachments of pupils, to get rid of some weak timber among those whose time has not expired.

I have had my physician carefully examine all those whose present condition of health indicate inability to go through with their school room work this winter, satisfactorily, and he informs me that in his judgment it would be best to send the following named;
