Sir.

Replying to yours of the 12th inst., marked "C" 15914, I have to say that my letter in regard to the Pueblos children was contingent on your not desiring to send me any more from the Indian Territory. I am satisfied with the present orders 'forty from the Indian Territory and fifty from Dakota.'

We are having such success in putting out children for the winter that I should feel free to undertake twenty to twenty-five more than your present orders send, but might not this difference rest for special or
