To the Hon.

The Comms. of Indian Affairs.

Sir:

Your letter of Oct. 6. Marked "L. Authority 6464" arriving at the time I was absent in Indⁿ Territory, Dakota, I now send herewith, in accordance with that letter, the Lease (5 copies) for the Hocker farm, signed by the members of the Executive Committee of the Board of Trustees.

At the meeting of the Board in May last the Executive Committee was authorized to act in all matters pertaining to the Trust, and it is the opinion of Judge Henderson, one of the Members, that we have full authority.
