Sir,

In reply to your Circular letter from "Accounts Division" dated April 29th 1884 marked "J. S. B" in regard to my last statement of Public Funds which shows a large sum on hand, I have to inform you that the funds referred to were what was required to bring in the 50 Apache pupils under your authority. They are in the hands of Agent Llewellyn in the shape of checks on the Assistant Treasurer U. S. at New York payable to my order and endorsed to Agent Llewellyn to be endorsed by him to the Rail Road Company in payment of transportation and to other parties for necessary expenses for the 50 children from his Agency to Carlisle. The course I have pursued in this matter seems necessary and the best.
