To the Honorable

The Commissioner of Indian Affairs
Washington D. C.

Sir,

I am informed by Laban J. Miles Agent for the Osages that when the last party of children from his Agency came to Carlisle June 9th 1882, he promised the parents of three of them their children should return when the party now to go home returned to their Agency. He names only two Edward Choteau and Peliza evidently having omitted inadvertently the third.

His promise should be kept, and the children sent home. I would suggest that Peliza be sent here from Lincoln Institution to which she was transferred in Jan'y, and that I be allowed to send the three home. I
