To the Hon.

The Commr. of Indian Affairs,
Washington, D.C.

Sir:-

I have the honor to report my return to Carlisle on yesterday. I brought with me fifty-seven boys and girls from Laguna; fourteen from Acoma; four from Cochiti, and two from James — seventy-seven (77) in all, of whom 37 are girls and 40 are boys.

During my absence I visited the Osage Agency and arranged with Agt. Miles, who will bring or send in forty to fifty Osages. I also visited the Mescalero Agency, and left funds with Agt. Llewellyn, who promised to start East tomorrow (26th) from Las Cruces N.M. with fifty (50) of his Apache youth — 25 girls and 25 boys.

I secured a rate of \$35.⁰⁰ each

of \$19.⁴⁰ for the Osages from Tulsa to Carlisle,
and \$43.²⁶ for the party I brought in
from Albuquerque; but I had to pay an
additional \$2.⁷⁰ each to get them from
Laguna to Albuquerque -
