I I would have increased our number to as to include the whole harty of Osages, but for the fact, that both the Bages and Opaches sent almost exclusively boys -(lighty five boys to fifteen gives), and this crowded our boys room to its fullest extent

and the additional girls that we could have accommodated did not seem to be within our reach, except by making greater effort than the pressure ofour work allowed. In regard to the latter clause of your letter - 6. + 6. 19940 + 205,6, 2 Thave to day, that from the very nature of the Case, it would be impracticable to Keep Separate accounts for each item. of expense covering these children, and I hope that this course in making the application will not be found inconsistent with a first management of the matter.
