To the Hon.

The Commr. of Indian Affairs,
Washington, D. C.

Sir:-

I forward herewith special estimates to cover maintenance of twenty-three (23) Osage pupils. We are carrying at the School this year an average of about thirty-five (35) students more than we have appropriation for. We have fifty-seven (57) Osages - fifty-three (53) at the School; but I do not need money for the whole - what I ask for will be sufficient to see us safely through the year.

I would have increased our number so as to include the whole party of Osages, but for the fact, that both the Osages and Apaches sent almost exclusively boys - (eighty-five boys to fifteen girls), and this crowded our boys room to its fullest extent

and the additional girls that we could have accommodated did not seem to be within our reach, except by making greater effort than the pressure of our work allowed.

In regard to the latter clause of your letter - C. & E. 19940 + 20506, I have to say, that from the very nature of the case, it would be impracticable to keep separate accounts for each item of expense covering these children, and I hope that this course in making the application will not be found inconsistent with a just management of the matter.
