Sir :

There is enclosed herewith a communication from R. H. Pratt, Superintendent of the Indian School at Carlisle Pa., transmitting a letter from the Representative of the Bureau of Education at the New Orleans Exposition, who states that the Representative of the French Government asks for a part or the whole of the Carlisle School Exhibit as a donation to the Educational material of France, and that this request is warmly endorsed by Gen. Eaton, U. S. Commissioner of Education.
