Sir:-

In reply to yours of the 6th inst.
- Marked C. & E. 6672 - I have to
say that I shall be glad to let
the Osages go.

On Monday we sent home one girl
and fourteen boys, which relieved
us of the worthless and least desirable.
This leaves thirty-one boys and twelve
girls, and it will be better to send
all to Martinsburg. A number are
out on farms for the summer; but I
will recall them so that the party
may go intact at any time after
Thursday next.
