Sir:-

I will have all arrangements made for receiving the Osage pupils on the 15^{inst}. Capt. Pratt has kindly invited me to come for the pupils so that they can explain to me something of their progress &c. If you will arrange for the transportation you will get at the distance by adding 22 miles to distance from Carlisle to Altoona. We are 22 miles south of Altoona on Hollidaysburg Branch Road. The R. R. Agent should send me two passes, from Martinsburg to Carlisle and return, as it is necessary to have some assistance.

I will notify Capt. Pratt that we

will leave home, for his place, on
the 13 inst, and expect to start with pupils
on the 15 inst.
