Cartersville, Ga., Sept. 19<sup>th</sup> 1885

To the Hon.

The Commissioner of Indian Affairs  
Washington D. C.

Sir:

In compliance with your letter of August 24<sup>th</sup> 1885 marked "O & E" I have the honor to report that the following irregular labor will be required at this school during the month of October next to wit:

Roll of Indian Apprentices \$200.<sup>00</sup>  
 One Baker - no regular baker being employed, 27 days at \$1.<sup>25</sup> per day, \$33.<sup>75</sup>, One Harness Maker, no regular Harness Maker being employed, 27 days at \$1.<sup>00</sup> per day \$27.<sup>00</sup>, One Carpenter assisting in finishing New Dining Hall & Laundry, 27 days at \$2.<sup>00</sup> per day \$54.<sup>00</sup> One Fireman for Steam Boilers 27 days at \$1.<sup>25</sup> per day \$33.<sup>75</sup>, Two Seamstresses Making & Repairing Clothing for pupils 27 days each at 65 Cents & 60 Cents per day respectively \$33.<sup>75</sup> and one Assistant Disciplinarian, Assisting in the care of large boys \$10.<sup>00</sup> amounting in the aggregate
