Sir;

I have the honor to report that the following irregular services will be required at this school during the month of December 1885, viz Roll of Indian Apprentices \$225.<sup>00</sup>, One Baker - no regular baker being employed \$15.<sup>00</sup>, One Hoop Maker, no regular Hoop Maker employed, 27 days at \$1.<sup>00</sup> per day \$27.<sup>00</sup> One Carpenter assisting in fitting up new Dining Hall and Laundry, 27 days at \$2.<sup>00</sup> per day \$54.<sup>00</sup>, 3 Beamstresses \$50.<sup>00</sup>, One Fireman for steam boilers \$30.<sup>00</sup>, and one Musical Instructor \$12.<sup>00</sup> amounting in the aggregate to \$413.<sup>00</sup>
