Sir:

I forward herewith the nomination of George W. Kemp as Harness-Maker at a salary of six hundred dollars (\$600.<sup>00</sup>) per year.

I have had no Harness-maker since May 31. last, having allowed one of my Indian boys to manage the shop; which has not been fully satisfactory, because of his want of information and sufficient tact to handle the apprentices.

Mr. Kemp was in our service from September to May of last fiscal year. He is an exceptionally good workman. I dropped him because his services were not satisfactory by reason of

SIR: In compliance with instructions,\* I forward herewith a Descriptive Statement of changes which I propose to make, subject to your approval, among the School Employés at this Agency.

\* Instructions to Agents require that every change of employés shall be reported to the Commissioner, for his action, at the time such change takes place.

In the descriptive statement, the SEX may be designated by the letter M for *male* and F for *female*; the RACE by W for *white*, N for *negro*, I for *Indian*, H for *half-breed*, C for *Chinese*, &c.; the correct AGE is to be given when *known*—when it is *estimated*, a line should be drawn under the figures; S designates *single*, and M *married*.

The reports of "Changes in School Employés" are not to be considered as a substitute for "Quarterly Reports of School Employés." The latter must be made regularly and promptly, without regard to these.
