Sir:

I have the honor to forward herewith for your approval, a voucher covering traveling expenses incurred by one of my employes, under my orders, in going after and returning with Henry Neoke, a runaway pupil of this School, the circumstances of which were fully detailed in my letter to you of the 14<sup>th</sup> ultimo.

After letting the case rest for several weeks I sent circulars to all the small Post Offices in the vicinity where he would be likely to pass. In response to this I had a letter from a farmer near Saxton, Bedford Co. Pa. The boy had arrived at a neighbor's
