I have the honor to report that the following Irregular Service will be required at this School during the month of February 1886, viz: Roll of Indian Apprentices \$225.<sup>00</sup> One Baker - no regular Baker employed - \$15.<sup>00</sup> One Carpenter assisting in general work and repairs, 24 days at \$2.<sup>00</sup> per day, \$48.<sup>00</sup> - 3 Steamstresses - \$50.<sup>00</sup> - One fireman for Steam boilers, \$30.<sup>00</sup> - One Musical Instructor \$12.<sup>00</sup> - One Assistant Disciplinarian, assisting in care of large boys \$10.<sup>00</sup> - For emptying Privy vaults, 20 days at \$2.<sup>50</sup> per day \$50.<sup>00</sup> Amounting in the Aggregate to \$440.<sup>00</sup>
