To the Hon.

The Commr. of Indian Affairs,
Washington, D.C.

Sir:-

It is discovered that Olive Shoique, a pupil of this School who arrived from Laguna, N.M. the 5th of October last, is enceinte, and within three months, or less, of delivery. As the copulation antedates the period of her admission, and her presence here until the time of her confinement would be detrimental to the moral interests of the School, I desire to return her to her people.

Olive says that Wa-ro, or We-a-ro, the son of Gue-at-te, of the Pa-wat-te Village at Laguna, where she lives, is the father of her child; that they were engaged to be married, and that she was with him one night about a month before coming to Carlisle. I would recommend the Pueblo Agent be instructed to have the Gov^r of

Laguna require the young man to marry the girl as soon as she reaches home.

+ Inez Santiagito, another girl from the same village, has been in feeble health for some time, and is threatened with consumption. My Physician urges that as the other girl is going home it would be better to send Inez at the same time. It will be necessary to send a care-taker along.

I therefore respectfully request your authority to send these two girls and one of my employes to Laguna, N.M., and that three (3) tickets be furnished from Carlisle to Laguna, and one (1) ticket from Laguna to Carlisle, and also authority to pay the necessary incidental expenses en route.
