At the earnest and repeated
solicitations of the parents. I ask Anshant
to take the following Esage children back
to the Agency on my return. Emma Ross
Miss Carlton & Peliza Moshwkeh etc.
The first returned to Carlisle in the fall
of 1884. to complete her three years term
and was accompanied with her cousin Miss
Carlton. with the promise that they should
return home together. the latter Peliza Moshwkeh
has been east. near 4 years altogether. and
her parents are anxious for her return
her mother is fast failing in health. reports
are that she cannot live long and pleads to
see her daughter before she dies -
I believe it an act of justice that the
requests of the parents be complied with

anxiety.

I ask that I be early informed in
regard to this matter.
