The Commissioner of Indian Affairs
Washington D. C.

Sir

A telegram from Mrs Margrave at
Neohart Neb. yesterday morning inform-
ed me that the mother of Joe Roubidoux
a Sac & Fox pupil at this School, would
not live but a few days, and urged
that her son be sent home at once.

I accordingly sent him on the midnight
train last night, The Rail-Road agt.
here furnishing a second class ticket
from Carlisle to White-Cloud Kansas.

The agent was unable to give the price
of the ticket until he corresponded
with his Chief in Phila.

Twenty five dollars and thirty cents
is the regular second-class rate, but
the agt. thinks that they will make it

lower than that.

I respectfully request your authority
for sending this pupil home, and your
approval of his traveling expenses.
