I have the honor to report that the following

employed) \$15.⁰⁰, One Carpenter assisting in general
work and repairs 26 days at \$2.⁰⁰ per day \$52.⁰⁰,
Three Steamtraps \$55.⁰⁰, One Assistant in Laundry
\$12.⁰⁰, One Assistant Disciplinarian assisting in care
of large boys \$10.⁰⁰, One Brickmaker 26 days at \$1.⁵⁰
per day \$39.⁰⁰ Amounting in the aggregate to \$408.⁰⁰
