Sir:

Sin-de-ha-ha (William Hamilton) one of the Ojibwa Councilmen who recently visited Washington, requests me to write you in his behalf, asking for the return of his son who is attending the Indian School at Carlisle Penn. Since Sin-de-ha-ha's return from Washington he has been very sick, and is still in very feeble health. He has no one to assist him in working his farm, as all his children are absent from home attending school. I have personal knowledge of his case and believe it would be just and right to allow his son Joseph Hamilton to return home
