Sir:

Annie Thomas of Acoma and Bennie Thomas of Laguna have each been at this school five years. In 1884 they were sent home by reason of expiration of the three years for which they had come. At the end of the vacation they returned to Carlisle with a party which came for a five years course. It is now urged by their parents, through the Governors of their respective villages, that Miss Shields, who was my Agent to collect the Students, promised their parents they should return at the end of two years. Miss Shields is not here, and there is no evidence to sustain the claim, but I feel assured it is well founded, and I would therefore recommend
