Sir:

Miss Hyde, who resigned her position in charge of the girls at this School, has consented to stay a part of the month of July while we are making alterations in the girls' quarters. I request your authority to continue her pay on the regular roll. I find it necessary to keep some one to go to the students who are out on farms through vacation, and request your authority to employ such a one temporarily at \$2 a day,--paying on the ^{ir} regular roll. During this period, I find additional clerical force necessary in my office, and request your authority to employ temporarily, an additional clerk at \$2 a day.

These several expenses will not increase my estimate for employes for the present fiscal year, for the reason that a number of appointments are not yet made and a number of the teachers sacrifice one month's pay in order to get two month's rest.
