Sir:

The return of Harriet Mary, one of our Nez Perce pupils, who came to us February 20, 1886, is now demanded by her mother, who removed from Indian Territory to Idaho with a detachment of the Nez Perce last year. She is entitled to go home and I recommend it. Agent Montieth writes that he has suggested to the Office, that the new Agent of the Nez Perce call here and take her.

I have therefore to respectfully request that transportation from Carlisle to Lewiston, Idaho, or the Railroad point for the Nez Perces, be furnished the new Agent.

Harriet is sufficiently advanced to be of considerable use in the Agency school.
