Agent informs him, that no arrangement has yet been made for the transportation necessary. Your letter of Aug. 13, marked C. C. 21354-86 says, "that requisition on the R. R. officials for this ticket had been made and the girl was probably then on her way." As there seems to be a mistake somewhere I ask that the matter be investigated and rectified with as little delay as possible.
