I have the honor to report that the following irregular services will be required at this school in the month of November 1886 viz Roll of Indian Apprentices \$200.⁰⁰, 1 Carpenter assisting in general repairs 26 days at \$2.⁰⁰ per day \$52.⁰⁰ 1 Fireman assisting in care of Steam boilers 26 days at \$1.⁵⁰ per day \$32.⁵⁰, 1 Instructor in Vocal Music \$25.⁰⁰, 1 person repairing Mattresses & Pillows 26 days at \$1.⁰⁰ per day \$26.⁰⁰, 1 Mason on repairs 20 days at \$2.⁵⁰ per day \$50.⁰⁰, 1 Assistant in Laundry \$12.⁰⁰, 1 Assistant in Bakery 26 days at 50 Cents per day \$13.⁰⁰ aggregating \$410.⁵⁰,
