I have the honor to report that the following Irregular Service will be required at this School during the month of January 1887, viz:- Pay Roll of Indian Apprentices \$200.⁰⁰; 1 Carpenter assisting in general repairs 26 days at \$2.⁰⁰ per day \$52.⁰⁰; 1 Fireman assisting in care of Steam Boilers, \$30.⁰⁰; 1 Instructor in Vocal music \$25.⁰⁰; 1 person repairing Mattresses and Pillows, 26 days at .60[¢] per day \$15.⁶⁰; 1 Mason on repairs 6 days at \$2.⁵⁰ per day \$15.⁰⁰; 1 Assistant in Laundry \$12.⁰⁰ - Aggregating \$349.⁶⁰ -
