The Commis. of Indian Affairs,
Washington, D.C.

Sir:

In order to maintain proper relations between the Government and the "Hocker" farm property, and also to meet the necessary expenses of keeping the farm in repair, and cover other expenses incidental to its possession, I deem it best, and am sustained by the Board of Trustees in whom the title rests, to continue a rental for it. I therefore propose that from the 1st of July next a yearly rental of Six hundred dollars (\$600.00) be allowed, and that the inclosed agreement may be renewed by your indorsement from July 1st covering an extension of the lease at the rate of Six hundred dollars
