Sir:

In accordance with your letter of the 5<sup>th</sup> inst., marked *F. Sch. Exp. Letter 16746-87*, I have the honor to forward herewith in duplicate, agreement of the Executive Committee of the Board of Trustees to reduce the rent of the "Hockett" farm from one thousand dollars (\$1000.-) to six hundred (\$600.-) dollars per annum from July 1<sup>st</sup> 1887 to July 1<sup>st</sup> 1888, and not from April 1<sup>st</sup> 1887 to April 1<sup>st</sup> 1888, as mentioned in your letter.
