The Commr. of Indian Affairs,

Sir,

In forwarding, on the 19th inst., my request for irregular service for the month of December next, the instructions in your letter of the 7th inst. were inadvertently overlooked. I now have respectfully to inform you that the Carpenter, 26 days at \$2.⁰⁰ per day - \$52.⁰⁰ and Mason - 10 days at \$3.⁰⁰ per day - \$30.⁰⁰ in all \$82.⁰⁰ are required for labor and repairs on buildings. The other labor asked for, amounting to \$362.⁵⁰ is required for general service.
