The Commr. of Indian Affairs,
Washington, D. C.

Sir:

I forward herewith for your action two letters, one dated Pine Ridge Agij. from Wallace Charging Shield, ^{aged 18,} a former pupil of this school, who came Nov. 9, '82 and returned home June 14, 1887. He was a satisfactory pupil and I would be glad to have him come back to the school. The other young man I know nothing about beyond his letter. Under your regulation he should go to Haskell, but as Haskell, Chillico and Genoa have been freely taking our returned pupils, the regulation seems to be a dead letter, and as it might be you would allow him to come here
