The Commr. of Indian Affairs

Washington, D. C.

Sir:

My School Physician recommends that the following named students be sent home because of unsound health: Jno. M. Davis, aged 18 who came to Carlisle Aug. 24. 1884, Istea Owastea, aged 18, who came at the same time, Priscilla Showitz, aged 17, who came Oct. 4. 1885, Ruth Kisero, aged 13, who came Aug. 24. 1884 and Ida Buffalo Thigt, aged 17, who came Sept. 21. 1886. They are all able to be about and go to school more or less, but my Physician thinks their health such that they will be unable for a long time to follow the course at the school with advantage, and I concur with him that

They had better go home. They will be able to take care of themselves en-route.

I would be glad if I could have the authority so that they might start on Monday next, as I would then have an opportunity of placing them under some supervision part of the way, without additional cost for escort. There will be needed four (4) tickets to Laguna New Mexico, and one (1) to Oklahoma, Ind. Terry, and the authority for the necessary expenses.
